Sir/Madam,

The undersigned has been appointed as Returning Officer for conducting the election of Delegates, Directors and Chairman of the Kendriya Bhandar as per the provisions of the Multi-Cooperative Societies Act (MSCS Act) 2002, Rules framed thereunder and the byelaws of Kendriya Bhandar.

2. Kendriya Bhandar is a Multi-State Cooperative Society registered under MSCS Act 2002. The General Body of the Society comprises of delegates who are elected out of the shareholders (Members) of the Society as per the byelaws of the Society. As per the byelaws of the Society, the Members (shareholders) **have been grouped into 18 constituencies** on the basis of the Ministry/Department, its attached/subordinate offices and the places where the Members are employed.

3. In exercise of the powers vested as Returning Officer, the undersigned has to appoint a Presiding Officer-cum-Assistant Returning Officer and also Polling Officers for the purpose of conducting the election of delegates of the Society.

4. Election is required to be held in Constituency No.18, which also includes employees working in Central Water Commission and various other offices located in West Block, R.K.Puram. For this purpose, election is scheduled to be held at a Polling Booth to be set up at Kendriya Bhandar, West Block, R.K.Puram.

5. **Shri R.K.Sharma, Section Officer, Shri Ranjan Kumar Chandna, ASO and Shri D.K.Sinha, UDC all of whom are working in CWC have informally conveyed their willingness to work as Presiding Officer and Polling Officers respectively.**



These staff are required to be available for conducting election on 6th September 2017 at Kendriya Bhandar, West Block, R.K.Puram on 6th September 2017 and for counting of votes at Nirman Bhavan on 7th September 2017
