
(a) the elected candidate will submit the copy of permission letter obtained from his/her office to hold elective office as per the provisions of relevant Conduct Rules to the Kendriya Bhandar immediately, **in any case latest by 15th September 2017;**

(b) the elected candidate should be presently working in an office which is part of the Constituency to which he/she has been declared elected. Otherwise, he/she shall be disqualified automatically to hold the post of delegate.

(c) he/she shall not attract any disqualification under any of the provisions of relevant Bye-laws of Kendriya Bhandar or the relevant provisions of the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act 2002.

3. It is intimated that further process of election to the Board of Directors and Chairman shall be held as per the schedule indicated vide enclosure to Annexure III of Notification dated 01st August 2017.
